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## **Membership Financial Obligations**

#### Insurance

Is covered by the hourly rate and dues. If necessary, an assessment may be charged to each member. Such an assessment would be discussed and voted upon at a meeting before being implemented.

#### **Application Fee**

Once voted into the club, an application fee of \$500.00 and \$75 for first month of membership is due by all new members.

#### **Change In Membership Status**

Any change in membership status or termination of membership, must be made in writing to the club Secretary/Treasurer. Termination of monthly fees and determination of final account balance will be calculated on a full month basis.

Example: Letter of resignation received on July 8th will be effective on August 1.

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#### **Elkins Pilots Club Rules**

- 1. Comply with all FARs at all times.
- 2. A weather briefing must be obtained, and a flight plan filed for EVERY cross-country flight.
- 3. Any pilot that has not flown within the preceding ninety (90) days must take a check-ride with a Club Instructor before flying any Club aircraft.
- 4. Any member with an overdue account in excess of sixty (60) days is grounded until that account is **paid in full.**
- 5. Applicants for membership must have a personal history statement on file before their membership acceptance vote is taken.
- 6. Any applicant must leave the meeting during the membership vote.
- 7. Each new member that has a pilot certificate must be checked out by one of the Club Instructors before they can fly Club aircraft.
- 8. Each member with a student certificate must receive an Instructor's "OK" before any flight.
- 9. Each pilot is responsible to ensure all certificates and manuals are in the aircraft before take-off.
- 10. Aircraft must be scheduled before departure, showing planned departure-time and planned return-time with Bookourplane.
- 11. If the person scheduled to fly the aircraft is late by thirty (30) minutes for a local flight, or one (1) hour for a cross-country flight, the aircraft is considered open to other members during that period.
- 12. Minimum charge for overnight flights is two (2) hours per day.
- 13. Each person flying the aircraft is responsible for assuring the oil and fuel are at proper levels when operating the aircraft.
- 14. When the flight is complete, the pilot is responsible for cleaning bugs off windshield, leading edges of wings, propeller, cowling, and wheel pants. (please only use approved cleaner for windshield)
- 15. Each pilot is responsible for securing the aircraft either local or cross-country.
- 16. Each pilot is responsible for all landing, tie down fees, etc.. While on cross-country flights.
- 17. Each member is responsible for loss of, or damage to Club equipment while that equipment is in their care, including any part not paid by insurance.
- 18. No one is allowed to purchase or sell anything in the Club name.
- 19. Club aircraft may be landed only on FAA approved airports.
